



# Guide to getting a seat from Bicester Village to London Marylebone

## Weekday morning services Monday 9<sup>th</sup> – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July

On weekdays during the Oxford improvement works (**Monday 9<sup>th</sup> – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> July**), trains will be much busier than usual from/to Bicester Village at peak travel times.

We know not everyone can change the time they travel, but if possible, you may wish to travel outside of peak times for a more comfortable journey.

Use the below table as a guide for your journey.  
Remember: this is based on a normal undisrupted weekday when trains are running to time and at the intended length. At times of service disruption, predictions will alter.

- Green:** Passengers can expect a good choice of seats.
- Yellow:** Most passengers can expect to get a seat. There will be more free seats towards the rear of the train. Some passengers may have to stand on busy days.
- Red:** This train is unlikely to have many spare seats and passengers can expect to stand. If getting a seat is a priority, please try the train before or the train after.
