






# Wembley Stadium to Birmingham Moor Street













## Championship Play-Off Final

On Monday 27<sup>th</sup> May, Aston Villa play Derby County at Wembley Stadium. Trains will be much busier than usual from Wembley Stadium to Birmingham Moor Street, between 17.00 and 21.00. There will be a queuing system in place with extended queuing times at Wembley Stadium.

We know not everyone can change the time they travel, but if possible, you may wish to travel outside of peak times for a more comfortable journey.

Use the below table as a guide for your journey.  
Remember: this is based on a normal undisrupted weekday when trains are running to time and at the intended length. At times of service disruption, predictions will alter.

-  **Green: Passengers can expect a good choice of seats.**
-  **Yellow: Most passengers can expect to get a seat. There will be more free seats towards the rear of the train. Some passengers may have to stand.**
-  **Red: This train is unlikely to have many spare seats and passengers can expect to stand. If getting a seat is a priority, please try the train before or the train after.**
