

Meet the Manager Q&A Aylesbury Station – 23 November 2016

Question/Comment	Response
Can there be the addition of large circular clock on the bottom bridge when it was completed in place of the digital clocks that run at the bottom of the CIS	It is not proposed to include this in the current bridge and canopy works.
How long will the bridge/canopy works last? What is the purpose of the works?	Weather permitting, the building works are expected to finish in April. The works are to repair defects in the bridge and canopies, including the replacement of rotten timbers, and treatment of corrosion.
Will there ever be a faster service into London via Aylesbury?	We would also like to run faster services to London via Amersham, but we have to share tracks with much slower London Underground trains between Amersham and Harrow-on-the-Hill. We work closely with London Underground to try and improve the journey times in the timetable where possible.
Can't always get a car parking space and the prices are too expensive	Nearby Aylesbury Vale Parkway station has ample car parking and the charge is only £3.50.
One of the bike racks has been closed off during the building works.	We are sorry about the reduction in cycle parking during the construction works. We plan to create a shelter for a temporary bike rack at the front of the station.
When will the trains on the Aylesbury line be fitted with WiFi?	The project to fit free WiFi to these trains is underway and will be completed in Spring 2017.
